Hello partners and friends,

There has been so many messages the Spirit of God has spoken to our spirits this year, but especially in approaching this new year one word has stood out. *Fulfillment.*

If Jesus delays His coming, **2026 is a Year of Fulfillment!** If The Lord does not delay His Return, it will still be a year of *Fulfillment!*

Do you hear what the Spirit is saying? Get excited and expectant about *Fulfillment. . . this year!*

The word The Lord gave us for 2025 was *Humility*, and looking back over 2025 I can testify that whether things went well or poorly was directly connected to how much humility I walked in. Just because we are stepping into 2026 does not mean of course that we can leave humility behind. We have learned that in God's wisdom His Spirit will emphasize certain things for times, seasons and years to spare us from evil and set us up for good!

Fulfillment is defined as something being put into effect, to execute, to meet the requirements of, to satisfy, to bring to an end. It also means to develop the full potentialities of a thing and (I really like this!) *to convert into reality*.

In our ministry and personal life, we have had much fulfillment in 2025 already. We have published 4 ministry books, moved our ministry and staff to California from Florida, grown in churches in Africa and divinely connected with precious people we never expected.

We have so much to be Thankful for! But much of what we have done in obedience and faith this past year was in the hope of something. The hope of something *more*, something *greater*. The Hope of Fulfillment.

You may have been experiencing the same thing, but can I tell you that God never meant for His command and our obedience to be the end of it. When God puts the promises of His Word in our hearts, whether it be the new birth, baptism in the Spirit, provision, healing, favor and promotion etc. – He wants them fulfilled. He wants them *all fulfilled*. When God makes a promise, He keeps it.

**[10] For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven,  
And do not return there without watering the earth  
And making it bear and sprout,  
And furnishing seed to the sower and bread to the eater;  
[11] So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth;  
It will not return to Me empty,  
Without accomplishing what I desire,  
And without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it.**  
- Isaiah 55:10-11 NASB95

The same word for *word* in the Bible is also translated *promise*. God wants a **"return"** on His Word, that His promises to be **"accomplished"** in our lives. Every word, every promise, completely fulfilled!

In our recent message series The Lord led us to the words He spoke to the Old Testament prophet, Ezekiel. I believe them to be very relevant to us –

**[21] Then the word of the Lord came to me, saying, [22] “Son of man, what is this proverb you people have concerning the land of Israel, saying, ‘The days are long and every vision fails’?**  
- Ezekiel 12:21-22 NASB95

By this proverb, the people of Israel heard all the words spoken through Ezekiel and put them off to a later time or said they never came to pass. It is a form of the traditions of men that Jesus spoke about that makes the Word of God have no effect in people's lives (see Mark 7).

They were saying something *other* than what God said because they did not believe what God said. This is an example of unbelief. If we do that concerning the promises of God, we will not experience the promises of God fulfilled in our lives. Others who believe will receive, but not those who believe something other. God still loves them, but it takes our faith to receive.

Looking at what The Lord God went on to say to Ezekiel is in our best interest.

**[23] Therefore say to them, ‘Thus says the Lord God, “I will make this proverb cease so that they will no longer use it as a proverb in Israel.” But tell them, “The days draw near as well as the fulfillment of every vision.**

- Ezekiel 12:23 NASB95

*The fulfillment of every vision! Hallelujah!*

Now, when you hear *vision*, do not necessarily think being caught up in a trance like John did in the book of Revelation. The Bible says God's Word gives us vision. That is what *hope* is : a good vision or image of expected Blessing from God! This is why the Psalmist says,

**I am counting on The LORD;  
yes, I am counting on Him.  
I have put my hope in His word.**

- Psalms 130:5 NLT

We put our hope, our good vision of expected Blessing, in God's Word – The LORD's promise. And we do not have to pick and choose one promise over another or have some and not others. We can have them all in Christ!

**For all of God's promises have been fulfilled in Christ with a resounding “Yes!” And through Christ, our “Amen” (which means “Yes”) ascends to God for his glory.**

- 2 Corinthians 1:20 NLT

All of God's promises are already fulfilled in Christ – and all who are in Christ can simply receive those promises by faith. So be expecting *big*, have your hope *set high in The Lord!*

Do not concern yourself if you can do or have or give something according to the natural – you can do all things through Christ who empowers you. Our job is simply to believe it (see John 6:29), say "Amen!" and act accordingly. God will meet your faith with His grace.

**The Scripture says, No man who believes in Him [who adheres to, relies on, and trusts in Him] will [ever] be put to shame or be disappointed.**

- Romans 10:11 AMPC

In other words, no one who trusts in God's Word will fail to have the fulfillment of God's promise!
