**“Get yourself up on a high mountain, O Zion, bearer of good news,
Lift up your voice mightily, O Jerusalem, bearer of good news;
Lift it up, do not fear. Say to the cities of Judah, “Here is your God!”
Behold, the Lord God will come with might, With His arm ruling for Him.
Behold, His reward is with Him And His recompense before Him.
~ Isaiah 40:9-10 NASB95 ~**

Hello beloved! God Bless you in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ, sent by God the Father to restore to us everything lost through sin and the devil – to bring all who will *back* to high life, the better than the good life, the God-kind of Life : the Christ Life. This Life of unity with God where no sin, sickness, lack, weakness or devil can overcome us.

Whatever you may be facing today, *Jesus* has already solved it. The Father has answered it – *in Him*. And guess what? *You are in Him!*

God has a promise for every aspect of our lives. Learning to trust God means taking what God has said and what God has promised in the Book, and apply it to that need or area of our lives. When we do that, we begin to see problems not as our defeat, but as opportunities for God to show up (see John 9:3). Hallelujah!

Remember, Adam spoke words over his situation that God never gave Him. God told Adam in the Garden of Eden, **"Who told you that you were naked?"** (Genesis 3:11)

Friend, I would like to ask you today,

Did God say you were running short? No. He said we are running over! Philippians 4:19 NASB95 — **And my God will supply all your needs** [that word means needs, wants and desires] **according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.**

Did God say you were to endure that sickness for His glory? No. He said health and healing bring Him glory! Psalms 118:17 NKJV — **I shall not die, but live, And declare the works of the Lord.**

The works of God bring glory to God. Healing is a work of God. Sickness is a work of the devil. Acts 10:38 NASB95 — **“You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and how He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.**

I am taking the time to say these things because we need to be reminded of them and what to do *when* – not *if* – we face the trials of life.

Did God say you are insignificant and nobody that He could use? No. He said expressly, Jeremiah 29:11 NIV — **“For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”**

Notice how the word ***plans*** is repeated 3 times in that one verse. ***Plans plans plans!*** Oh, does God have plans for you and me! God thought enough of you to not just have a plan, but to have many good plans for you. And this life is just the beginning!

Friend, there will always be one primary Plan for our lives, but in that plan is a multi-faceted arraignment of Blessing and assignments for the Kingdom. In it we abound in fruitfulness, experiencing His goodness on a level **“exceedingly abundantly above all we could ask or imagine”** (see Ephesians 3:20).

Here is the truth of the matter, friend : the Scripture says,

For as many as are the promises of God, in Him they are yes; therefore also through Him is our Amen to the glory of God through us.

- 2 Corinthians 1:20 NASB95

I like how one translation states it,

for it is he [Jesus] who is the “Yes” to all of God's promises. This is why through Jesus Christ our “Amen” is said to the glory of God.

- 2 Corinthians 1:20 GNTD

See, God gets glory when His promises of salvation, provision, healing, deliverance, protection, restoration, etc. come to pass in our lives.

All things can change for your good and God's glory. Even if they look dead and lifeless, void of the touch of God – He can resurrect it!

That is what our Featured Message is all about this month (found on the homepage of our website www.muchgrace.church). It is titled *Make Room for Resurrection*. Faith makes room for the resurrection power of God!

I wrote this out earlier this week as The Lord gave it to me. I was sitting up in bed writing it out when I got it and shared it that day on social media. Here it is again,

How powerful faith is can be seen in the Death and Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus knew He would be the sin substitute for all mankind. He bore all humanity's sin, death and curse. Christ took it with Him to the heart of the earth. But you see, Jesus did not go to the Cross of His own accord, did He. Faith comes by hearing from God and the Father told His Son to go, and He did. Faith, hope and love all came into play. In loving redemption for us, in loving obedience to His Father, in the hope of Resurrection.

Nobody had ever died like that before : on purpose, in sin, destination : Hell, and come back again. How powerful is faith. Jesus went to the Cross in faith. Faith conquered all the combined forces of sin, death, curse and Hell. Jesus' faith raised Him from the dead. And when He was raised, so were we. We were raised with Him. Faith is so powerful, just a mustard seed size of it will move a whole mountain. If faith did what it did through Jesus, what could it do through you . .

The question is never, "What if I believe God and nothing happens?" **For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes in Him will not be disappointed."** (Romans 10:11 NASB95) The truth is, if I do not get in faith, nothing will happen – things will stay the same or grow worse. If we believe, Jesus said, **"All things are possible to him who believes."** (Mark 9:23 NASB95) All ability and power are made available for our faith to receive.
